Our second / vacation home is in the Lake Almanor Country Chib on a lakeside lot where we have enjoyed the peace and tranquility of the area for over 30 years.

I have researched and read just about everything I can find regarding Thermal Curtains. Nowhere however have I been able to locate any data reflecting the original "who" or "why" or "legal requirement" for providing colder water to the lower reaches of the North Fork of the Feather River. What has happened to bring this proposal to the forefront?

How can any reasonable person be in favor of the Lake Almanor Thermal Curtains if:

- (1) There is no definite proof that colder water is advantageous. Looks like it is merely optimistic speculation.
- (2) The tremendous cost will be paid by us ratepayers.
- (3) The degradation of the fishing will undoubtedly occur in a take that is well known for its trout fishing.
