We are writing to you regarding the referenced FERC project which we recently became aware of since we own a home at Lake Almanor, California.

We would like you to know that we are <u>completely against</u> this absurb plan which would theoretically lower the water temperature for the trout habitat at the Rock Creek-Cresta area. Why upset the natural balance of two lakes for a one degree difference in the river. It would increase the water temperature in Lake Almanor and damage our cold water fisheries. It is our understanding that there will be a 700' x 900' thermal curtain installed in the lake which will require underwater dredging that will line our shores with muck.

This expensive (roughly 40 million dollars) and environmentally damaging project would be at the expense of PG&E ratepayers!!! WE SAY "NO" TO THIS PLAN! We urge you to halt FERC Project Number 2105.
