

The reason for this letter is my, much like many others, concern of our Lake and the future it has. Put simply I am asking you honor and uphold the Settlement Agreement from 2004 which was filed on behalf of Project 2105 which addressed reservoir lake levels, water quality, wildlife habitat enhancement, stream flows below the dam's project and recreation enhancements.

In addition, I ask you not allow any additional release of cold water from Lake Almanor beyond the agreed Settlement from 2004. Not only the quality of water in Lake Almanor would be adversely affected, also the health of our fisheries which is critical to our economy, our business and quality of life of our families and community.

We are nearly 20 years past the Settlement and still without the 2105 license. The promise and good faith which was negotiated should be upheld without any change. For the State Water Resources Control Board to change a single intent of the collaborative 2105 agreement is wrond and should not be considered by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

Thank you for considering the people of Lake Almanor, the fishery of Lake Almanor, the livelihood of our community and doing what is right. The right thing to do is support the collaborative settlement for the 2105 license without the unreasonable and unnecessary change that was added by the State Water Resources Control Board.
